**AP POLICY- GUIDELINES FOR RELEASE OF AGRICULTURAL PUMPSET
CONNECTIONS IN THE STATE OF PUNJAB**

1. Preamble :

Clause 5.3 (i) of the Electricity Supply Code notified by the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission provides that the State Government may for reasons of ecology, inadequate ground water potential, declining water table or any other reasons decide the number of Agricultural Pump sets (AP) connections and the manner in which these are to be released each year in the State or part thereof. The said Regulations further provide that the State Government may for this purpose draw up guidelines to provide for priorities to be assigned in release of such connections.

The Government of Punjab accordingly lays down Policy Guidelines to regulate release of Agriculture Pump Sets Connections in the State as follows: -

2. Present Status:

i) Punjab is predominantly an agrarian State having 85% of its geographical area under cultivation with an average cropping intensity of 189%. Water is the only natural resource available and the state is devoid of any other mineral or natural resource. Punjab's agriculture being highly intensive is dependent on heavy requirement of water. The present cropping pattern and the efforts to increase the productivity of food grains have led to immense strain on irrigation system due to limited surface water resources, which are grossly inadequate to meet our own requirements and is causing stress on ground water resources. Due to wheat-rice cropping pattern in major cultivated area of State, the dependency on ground water has enormously increased. This is evident from increase in the number of Tubewells from 0.19 million in 1970-71 to 1.384 million during 2010-11. Punjab has, therefore, to depend upon Tubewell irrigation to a large extent and 73% of its requirement for agriculture sector is being met with from ground water resources and only 27% from its surface water resources.

As per the latest Report on Dynamic Ground Water Resources of Punjab State as on 31.3.2004, out of the total 137 Blocks of the State taken for study 103 Blocks are over exploited where stage of ground water development is more than 100%. 5 Blocks are critical (90-100%), 4 Blocks are semi-critical (70-90% development) and only 25 Blocks are in safe category (<70% development). The net annual ground water availability is 21, 44,292 Ham (17.37 MAF) and total draft is 31,16,152 Ham (25.24 MAF). The net ground water availability for future irrigation

development in the state is negative i.e. -971860 Ham (-7.87 MAF). The block wise ground water development varies from 13% in Dhar Kalan (Gurdaspur District) to maximum of 350% in Jalandhar East (Jalandhar District). The stage of development for whole state has been worked out as 145%.

The Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) vide Notification No.32-1/CGWA/2001(e) dated 30.09.2003 declared 5 Blocks of State as notified areas i.e. Moga-I and Moga-II of Moga District and Sangrur, Mehal Kalan and Maler Kolla-II (Ahmedgarh) of Sangrur District, where the situation of ground water level was alarming and issued directions for registration of ground water abstraction structures. Also, Ludhiana City was declared as notified area. Three more Blocks i.e. Jalandhar East, Jalandhar West and Nakodar of Jalandhar District were notified for registration of ground water extraction structures vide notification dated 8.09.2006.

In the meeting of Punjab State Water Resources Committee (WRC), held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary on 7.7.2010, further course of action to be adopted on the directions issued by Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) to Principal Secretary, Irrigation and Power (PSIP) under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for the purpose of regulation and control of ground water development and management in the already declared "Notified Areas" of Ludhiana City and 5 Blocks in Moga and Sangrur Districts in Punjab State was discussed & it was decided that as a trial to improve the situation, all concerned DCs of these areas be issued directions to ensure the implementation of directions of CGWA to the extent to regulate ground water development and management in the "Notified Areas" by completely banning the process of drilling, construction, installation of any GW abstraction structure for commercial /industrial use or by farmers having holdings above 4 Hectare of land.

Keeping in view the alarming situation of over exploitation of Ground water as described above, there is an urgent need to formulate guidelines for release of electricity connections for agriculture pump sets.

ii) Of the total irrigated area of the State, 73% is irrigated by Tubewells. There are 14 Lac. (approximately) Tubewells presently installed in the State and of these 1143267 Nos. as on 31.03.2011 are operated with electricity connections of erstwhile Punjab State Electricity Board, now Punjab State Power Corporation

Limited (PSPCL). The number of Tubewell connections released by erstwhile Punjab State Electricity Board during the last Eight years are as under: -

3.0 Policy Guidelines:

3.1 The State Government would fix the target for release of AP connection for each year in the beginning of the year. The total number of AP connections released by Punjab State Power Corporation Limited in a year will not exceed the target fixed by the State Government.

For the year 2011-12, the proposed target is fixed as 25000 A.P. connections. Further, in order to clear the backlog of General Category applications pending since long, 50000 additional connections under ARTC scheme are proposed to be released on priority through outsourcing / departmentally in view of the present financial constraints of PSPCL. The detail for release of AP Tubewell connections under ARTC scheme is given in **Annexure-I**.

3.2 Of the total AP connections to be released in a year as per the target fixed, the category-wise break-up shall be as under:-

a) General Category	60%	(15000 Nos.)
b) Priority Categories	30 %	(7500 Nos.)
c) Providing connection under ARTC priority over and above (a & b)	90 % of total ARTC connections	(45000 Nos.)
d) Chairman's Discretionary Quota	10% of (25000+50000) =	7500 Nos.

3.3 Priority Categories :

It will be ensured that the Tubewell connections will be released as per ratio indicated below:-

A) General Category:

- i) Applicants with land holding upto 5 acre : 30% (7500 No.)
- ii) Applicants with land holding more than 5 acre : 30% (7500 No.)

B) **Chairman Discretionary Quota** : 10% as indicated above

C) **Following Priority Categories:-** : 30% (7500 No.)

- i) Punjab Water Resources Management & Development Corporation Limited) T/W Connection Priority.
- ii) Land Across International Border Fencing Priority.
- iii) Kandi Area (10 BHP and above Submersible Pumps only).
- iv) Priority Across the River Ravi.
- v) Priority under Family Partition.
- vi) Ex-Serviceman Priority.

- vii) Priority to Land Owners/Oustees whose lands are acquired by the Govt. of Punjab.
- viii) Priority for Members of Scheduled Caste
- ix) Gallantry Awardees (Armed Forces and Civilians)
- x) Martyrs of Kargil War, Operation Rakshak in J & K and insurgency.

3.3.1 Following additional priorities have been provided in the priority category list as brought out in the foregoing paras:-

(a) **Priority for Members of Scheduled Caste**

A priority Tubewell connection was admissible to the members of Scheduled Caste earlier also and issue of demand notice under this priority category was stopped w.e.f. 30.06.2001 vide CC No.45/2001 dated: 25.06.2001.

Now, the matter has been reviewed and it has been decided to relax the ban imposed on issue of Demand Notice under this priority. Under this priority, the applicant will be required to furnish a certificate of his being a member of scheduled caste on the requisite proforma from any of the following authorities:-

- (1) District Magistrate/ Additional District Magistrate/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- (2) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (3) Sub Divisional Officer of the Area where the applicant and / or his family normally resides.

(b) **Gallantry Awardees (Armed Forces and Civilians)**

One No. Tubewell connection on priority is admissible to defence and civilian personnel who are recipient of the awards as under:-

(I) **Indian Armed Forces Personnel**

- i) Param-Vir- Chakra
- ii) Mahavir Chakra
- iii) Vir Chakra

(II) **Civilian Officers/ Personnel**

- i) Bharat Ratna
- ii) Padam Vibhushan
- iii) Padam Bhushan
- iv) Padam Shri

- (iii) The applicant will submit a proof of having been awarded gallantry/Civilian award and will be entitled only one Tubewell connection under priority in this category during his life time provided he/ she does not have any other Tubewell connection in his/ her name in Punjab. An undertaking to this effect on a non-judicial stamped paper shall be submitted by the applicant.

(c) Martyrs of Kargil War, Operation Rakshak in J & K and Insurgency

- i) One No. Tubewell connection for agricultural purposes will be provided on priority to the family of each such Martyr.
- ii) In case of unmarried martyrs, the connection may be released in the name of parents and in case the parents are not alive, the same may be released in the name of Brother/ Sister after obtaining No Objection from the remaining Brother(s)/ Sister(s).
- iii) In case of martyrs, the connection may be released in the name of Wife or one No. children after obtaining No objection from other children, if any.
- iv) The legal heir of Martyrs will submit a proof and will be entitled only for one Tubewell connection under priority in this category during his life time provided he/she does not have any other Tubewell connection in his/her name in Punjab. An undertaking to this effect on a non-judicial stamped paper shall be submitted by the legal heir of Martyr.

3.3.2 Apart from above target of 75000 Nos., additional AP connections have been planned to be released under Sem Area Priority, Drip/Micro Sprinkler System Priority, Gram Panchayat/Religious Institutions (including Gaushala) Priority, Harijan Farmers Co-operative Society Priority without cut-off date. Besides, additional Tubewell connections under the following scheme/ category have been planned to be released over and above the fixed annual target for the year 2011-12.

i) **Priority for release of AP Connection to Gaushala:**

This priority will be included in the Religious Institutions Category for release of AP connection & shall be regulated as per terms & conditions mentioned in Annexure-II.

ii) **Release of common Tubewell connection on priority for irrigation of land alongside of Canal/ Distributaries:**

This priority will be governed as per terms & conditions mentioned in the enclosed Annexure-III.

iii) **Release of Tubewell connection on priority for Harijan Farmers Co-operative Society:**

This priority will be governed as per Terms & Conditions mentioned in the enclosed Annexure-IV

iv) **Pending Chairman's discretionary Quota for the year 2010-11:**

During the year 2010-11, about 75 No. T/W Connections have been granted under Chairman's discretionary quota against the fixed target of 1250 No. Hence it is proposed that the balance T/W Connections may be granted under Chairman's discretionary quota upto 30-09-2011.

3.3.3 The Tubewell connections to be released under Chairman's discretionary quota , Gram Panchayats/ Religious Institutions (including Gauthala) priority & Drip/ Micro Sprinkler system priority, Sem Area Priority , Release of Common Tubewell Connection on priority for irrigation of land alongside of canal/ distributaries and Accelerated Release of Tubewell Connection (ARTC) for General Category applicants will have overriding priority without any cut off date and may be released through outsourcing/ departmentally. Tubewell connection under Gram Panchayat priority in the name of Gram Panchayat may also be released in the Mushtarkha Malikana land managed by Gram Panchayat.

3.3.4 In general Category Queue, it will be ensured that 50% of Tubewell connections are released to the eligible small & marginal farmers having total land holding in the state upto 5 Acre.

3.3.5 All the priority applications / test reports already received under any other priority categories except those indicated above will be transferred in general category queue and the seniority of pending A.P. applications/test reports received in any other priority categories except those indicated above, will be determined on the basis of date of receipt of application for issue of demand notice and date of receipt of test report for release of connection under general category queue.

3.3.6 Cut off date for issue of Demand Notice/Release of Connection:

Keeping in view the pendency of AP applications, test reports & availability of material, PSPCL will decide the cut off dates for issue of demand notice & release of connection on the basis of receipt of application & test report respectively against General Category & Priority Categories.

3.4 All new AP connections of HVDS:

All new Tubewell connections, Whether of General Category or of Priority categories, will be released under HVDS by installing individual Transformers of appropriate capacities without LT line.

3.5 Minimum Land Holding for Tubewell Connection:

As per existing instructions, minimum land requirement for release of AP connections is one Acre as provided in AP policy guidelines approved by State Govt. except in case of Tubewells released under Drip/Sprinkler Micro irrigation priority & A.P. High technology priority. Minimum land holding for release of Tubewell under Drip/Sprinkler Irrigation System is 2 hectare for fruit crops or one hectare for vegetables & non horticulture crops & minimum land holding for green houses Tubewell connections to be released under A.P. High technology priority is 2000 sq. meters (4 Kanals). Similarly minimum area for setting up hot houses/net houses will be 2000 sq. meter (4 Kanals).

3.6 Seniority for release of AP Connection:

The AP applicants who become eligible for release of Tubewell connections will be released connections on the basis of seniority as per provision of Conditions of Supply/Supply Code.

3.7 Service Connection Charges for release of Tubewell Connections:

The Service connection charges are recoverable from the applicants seeking a new Tubewell connection or extension in load/ demand under AP category as prescribed by Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission in the Electricity Supply Code. As per an amendment made by Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission vide its Notification dated 24.5.2010, an applicant for new connection seeking out of turn release of connection/ load/ demand will be required to pay per BHP/ KW/ KVA charges or the actual expenditure incurred in providing the connection/ load/ demand whichever is higher.

Accordingly Service Connection Charges for release of new connection or extension in load/ demand under AP category will be recovered as under:-

- i) Service Connection Charges @ Rs. 3600/- per BHP (upto service line of 500 meter) from General category consumers.
- ii) Applicants for new connection seeking out of turn release of connection/ load/ demand will pay actual cost of release of connection or PSERC prescribed per BHP / KW/ KVA Service connection charges whichever is higher.

NOTE: Charges as above will be recoverable as revised by PSERC from time to time.

There may be large number of applicants who have already deposited requisite charges and have submitted the Test Reports with PSPCL before the issue of CC No. 9/2011 dated 17.2.2011 and are awaiting release of their Tubewell connections. Such connections shall be released as per terms & conditions of demand notices already issued. However, where the validity of demand notice already issued against any of the priority category have expired, extension demand notice will be allowed by the competent authority with the condition that demand notice extension fee and service connection charges applicable for priority category will be payable.

4.0 These policy guidelines shall come into force with immediate effect.

Annexure- " I "

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR TUBEWELL CONNECTIONS TO BE RELEASED UNDER ARTC SCHEME.

1. The applications/ option under proposed ARTC scheme shall be available to applicants already registered under General Category & pending for issue of Demand Notice.
2. The upper limit for accepting option shall be 45,000 Nos. which will be in addition to connection to be released for the pending T.Rs under various categories and connection to be released under general category as per tubewell policy for 2011-12 to be issued by State Govt.
3. The connections under ARTC shall be released on turnkey basis **through** open tender process or departmentally. The material conforming to standard specification of PSPCL will be purchased/ procured by the Contractors from approved suppliers of PSPCL.
4. The release of tubewell connections under the policy shall commence after July/Aug. 2011.
5. The scheme may be opened in the first phase for AP Applications registered upto 31.12.1992 for two weeks and if the response is less than target, of 45,000 No., then the scheme will be extended to AP Applicants registered upto 31.12.1994 for another two weeks and if still short of target, it will be extended upto 31.12.1996 for another two weeks. The scheme may close within six weeks from its start to enable timely floating of tenders etc.
6. 10% of total number of connections checking will be carried out by TA & I and Enforcement as per existing procedure.
7. The applicant will deposit presently applicable per BHP service connection charges @ Rs.3600/- per BHP or the actual expenditure (comprising of extending high voltage line, step down Substation and cost of service lines) incurred in providing the connection load whichever is higher.
