ORDER

GVK Power (Goindwal Sahib) Limited (GVK) has filed the present petition for approval of True up for Financial Year 2023-24, forecasting of the Aggregate Revenue Requirement for FY 2025-26 and Determination of Tariff for FY 2025-26. The petition has been placed before the Commission for admission. As per Regulation 11 of the PSERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Generation, Transmission, Wheeling and Retail Supply Tariff) Regulations 2022, the petition was required to be filed on or before 30th November 2024. PSPCL has requested to condone the delay in filing the petition. GVK Power (Goindwal Sahib) Limited was transferred to PSPCL w.e.f 07.02.2024 and keeping in view that it takes time in finalizing the accounts and other required formalities, the delay in filing the petition is condoned. After considering the averments made in the petition, petition is admitted.

- 4. Provide Details of design parameters with regards to pressure rating, steam temperatures, turbine efficiency, boiler efficiency, designed heat rate of the units, type of cooling tower, type of coal mills etc. along with documentary evidence.
- 5. GVK to provide balance sheets for the periods 01.04.2023 to 07.02.2024 and 08.02.2024 to 31.03.2024 in both PDF and Excel formats.
- 6. GVK to submit the provisional or actual balance sheet for the year 2024-25.
- 7. GVK to provide details of capital expenditures incurred during FY 2024-25 and their capitalization.
- 8. GVK to submit details of actual equity invested to justify the claimed RoE from 08.02.2024 to 31.03.2024 and for FY 2025-26.
- 9. GVK to provide justification for claiming depreciation on Rs. 3,072.81 crore from 08.02.2024 to 31.03.2024 when the plant was purchased by PSPCL for Rs.1,080 crore. The significant difference between the claimed depreciation and the purchase price by PSPCL requires clarification.

12.GVK to submit details of insurance expenses, legal charges, electricity charges,

water charges, security services, etc., claimed for FY 2023-24 and FY 2025-26,

along with reasons.

13.GVK to provide employee wise month wise details such as name of employee

designation, basic salary, dearness allowance, interim relief, overtime, bonus, other

allowances etc. of employee cost claimed for FY 2023-24 and FY 2025-26, along

with reasons.

The petition as well as the deficiencies observed by the Commission and

the Commission i.e. www.pserc.punjab.gov.in. The petition involves public interest and as
